## **The EnvironMentors<sup>®</sup> EnvironMentors Natural Resource Education Scholarship**

EnvironMentors Natural Resource Education \$10,000 Scholarship is available to EnvironMentors students who elect to pursue college degree programs in environmental science and other environmentally fields. To be an eligible candidate for the Natural Resource Education \$10,000 Scholarship, students must:

- 1) Participate in EnvironMentors for at least two years
- 2) Complete and present his or her EnvironMentors experimental research project to an elementary school class and at the EnvironMentors Fair at least one year
- 3) Participate in College Summit, equally rigorous college prep program, or taken college level courses during the summer of his/her rising senior year, and/or during the senior year
- 4) Conduct an internship with an environmental organization, agency, or business
- 5) Develop an EnvironMentors Portfolio of his/her full experience in EnvironMentors including first and second year mentors and projects, summer and/or academic year internships experiences, and any related experiences such as with Student Conservation Association
- 6) Be admitted to a four-year, accredited college or university and stated an intension to declare environmental science or related environmental field as a major
- 7) Be a citizen of the United States



## How to Use DC College Access Program (DC CAP)

District of Columbia College Access Program (DC-CAP), a non-profit organization funded by Washington-area companies and foundations, encourages and enables DC public high school students to enter and graduate from college. With corporate and foundation support, DC-CAP provides assistance to those students who might otherwise never have the opportunity to attend and graduate from college by providing the following:

- **Individual and group counseling**
- **College information resource centers**
- **College application assistance**
- **Financial aid assistance**
- **Parent education**
- **College student support services**
- **"Last dollar" award scholarships**

All DC public high school students are eligible for DC-CAP assistance and support. The program, located in the heart of the District, also places onsite advisors throughout the city's school system to provide on-going counseling with regard to the importance of higher education as well as financial aid information.

DC-CAP will work with DC public high school graduates for up to **five years** after high school graduation to make sure they are able to complete their college education. Each year, DC-CAP College Retention Advisors will assess the student's academic progress and financial resources, then help them plan (academically and financially) for their next year of college.
